#### **OUTREACH GRIEF SUPPORT**

Hello again, my Dear Ones.

This year WPS is hosting nine (9) five-week Grief Support Series, in the north, east, south, and west areas of the Metroplex to give widows and widowers a place to go not too far from where they live. This includes an evening session for those that work. If you have not been to one or need a refresher course this is for you.

Attend as many Grief Support sessions as you like. It gives you somewhere to go Sunday afternoons from 2:30 to 4:30 PM -and-you are greeting new friends who "have walked in your shoes."

"Grief Support" ......Donna stood outside in the parking lot trying to talk herself into entering the building. Once in the door, the next step would be to get to "that" room. The thought of it caused her palms to sweat and her heart pound. Then what? She would need to enter the room to meet a room full of strangers she did not know. "What did I get myself into?" she questioned. "Will I have to speak? What will people think about me? What if I cry?" Her fears were beginning to overcome her choice to be there. This raised her anxiety even more. She wondered, "Is it possible someone else feels the same? Why am I afraid?"

Over the forty-six (46) years we have been facilitating support groups, participants have expressed these feelings. Attending a support group for the first time can be intimidating. Let me suggest though, that sharing the experience with someone else, going through the loss of a loved one far outweighs the burden of thinking grief is something I should be able to manage on my own.

Today's groups are a mixture of men and women, young and old, and death situations that vary from sudden to anticipated to traumatic. Grief has no boundaries. Just like our fingerprints, we are all different individuals trying to live with the hand we have been dealt. Grief groups are a place to recognize that you are not alone. It's a place to heal. Don't pass up this opportunity. We make a lot of choices in life and when loss has complicated our day-to-day existence, choose to allow others to understand you, nurture you, and offer you their friendship. Our support can be the best choice you make in living after loss

#### **HOW DO I DONATE?**

It's easy! On Thursday, September 18, between 6:00 AM and Midnight:

- 1. You must use a credit card or debit card to donate. Donations must be made online only.
- 2. Using your computer or smartphone, go to <a href="www.northtexasgivingday.org">www.northtexasgivingday.org</a>.
- 3. At the top, in the Search window, enter "Widowed Persons Service of Tarrant County" and click the magnifying glass icon, then click on the Widowed Persons Service of Tarrant County icon box. Choose "Donate" and follow the instructions.
- 4. We prefer that you use your own name so that we will be able to recognize you as a donor. However, if you prefer that your donation remain completely anonymous, you may choose that option, also.
- 5. To complete the checkout process, choose "Pay \$xxx.xx." (You do not have to give the suggested 12% "tip" to Communities Foundation of Texas. Choose "Custom" on the pull-down menu and enter 0.00.)
- 6. Although NTX Giving Day is officially a one-day event, <u>you may donate at any time</u> from midnight August 28 until midnight September 17. Your card will not be charged until September 18.
- 7. You will receive an email confirmation of your donation and a printable receipt.
